RED

El Bucco, Montepulciano, Italy €50.00

High in juicy black fruit flavours, low tannin content, and balanced acidity.

Oyster Bay, Pinot Noir, New Zealand €35.00

Fragrant, soft and flavourful red wine, with aromas of ripe cherries and sweet fruit tannins.

Saint Claire, Pinot Noir, New Zealand €42.00

A powerful mix of dark berries with perfumed violets, olive, spices, and a tinge of freshly ground coffee on the nose.

Chateau Lagrange, France €60.00

The palate is full, well structured with velvety texture and flavours of red and black berry with lightly spiced plum, lifted by refreshing acidity and pleasurable aftertaste with persistent woody notes.

Elsa Bianchi, Malbec, Argentina €30.00

This Malbec is jammy, with medium tannins and medium acidity. It has notes of coffee, leather, black pepper, vanilla, and tobacco.

Luis Canas, Rioja, Spain €68.00

It has aromas of balsamic and fine nuances of plum and clean oak with intense spice and oak on layers of velvety cherry fruit and a slight hint of licquorice.

Terre Forti, Italy €38.00

This Italian red is made from the Sangiovese grape variety and shows aromas of red cherries, raspberry with smooth tannins.

Muddy Boots, Shiraz, Australia €32.00

Mildly scented, black fruits, blackberry, blackcurrant, medium bodied, a touch spicy with a soft texture.

Luciente, Tempranillo, Spain €32.00

Young wine, with the classic Rioja aromas of ripe plum and violet flowers with subtle hints of vanilla.
